Applications must be received by 31st October of the year in which the Award is to be made.

All eligible members who are over 16 years of age can apply to avail of the Education Bursary Award by completing the Bursary Application Form. Only one application per member is permitted and all application forms must be completed in full. An incomplete application will be considered null and void. Applicants under the age of 18 must also get their parent/legal guardian to countersign the application form.

Terms & Conditions:

1. All applicants must be a member of First Tech Credit Union for at least 12 months and maintain a minimum shareholding of €10.00 on account.
2. Applicants must be residing in the Republic of Ireland.
3. Applications for education support must be for a course undertaken with an education body that is recognised by the Department of Education.
4. The Scheme is not open to applications for courses in private colleges.
5. The credit union will accept applications for full-time courses only.
6. The course duration must be at least one year.
7. Applications will be accepted from students who have already commenced their course.
8. The successful applicant will receive the bursary on the condition that they have been accepted on a third level course and proof of acceptance will be required.
9. By completing the application form the applicants agree to allow the credit union to take photographs of them for publicity purposes
10. All application forms will be checked ensure that they have been filled out correctly.
11. The winning applicants will be picked at random by an independent adjudicator from total eligible entries received. Decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into. The successful applicant will be notified by post following the draw.
12. The draws for the winners will take place within 5 days after the closing date.
13. The Bursary will be paid into the winning applicant's credit union share account.
14. Those awarded a bursary may NOT apply in subsequent years. The bursary is a once off payment.
15. To ensure compliance with the Criminal Justice Act, 2010 (as amended from time to time) the member maybe required to produce to the credit union satisfactory evidence of identity and current permanent address and possibly source of funds by means of supporting documentation.
